

## Rules

The walk is open to any individual on submission of the necessary details and appropriate entry fee.

The walk will take place whatever the weather. Dogs must be kept under strict control at all times and are NOT allowed into the HQ.

Where they exist, footpaths must be used. The Country and Highway codes must be observed.

If the entrant fails to turn up or does not complete the walk, the entry fee will not be refunded or an award made.

Tally cards MUST be collected on registration and presented at the appropriate checkpoints.

Any walker who wishes to retire from their route must surrender their tally card to a checkpoint official.

Entries should be submitted before the day where possible, but entries will also be accepted on the day. (The 40k route is exempt from on the day bookings).

Children under 14 MUST be accompanied by an adult willing to take responsibility for them.

Unaccompanied walkers aged 14-18 can only take part in the 40k route if they have successfully completed the 20k route in previous years.

The organisers are not liable for accidents, thefts or damage to property. Every effort will be made by the organisers to make this a safe, enjoyable and memorable event.

Groups must undertake their own risk assessments.

## Baht'at Walk

The walk is a non-competitive event open to all families, groups and individuals. This event is organised by Aire Valley District Scout Council. This event is not a race; there will be a choice of distances, 10k (6m), 20k (12m) & 40k (24m). Whilst the longer distance may be physically challenging, the shorter distance is a good introduction to walking. Groups of 10 or more, who enter as a team and pass through all check points also qualify for a team award, at no extra cost (minimum of 8 to finish).

Every individual who officially enters and completes a chosen route, will receive a commemorative badge and certificate.

**The route will be marshalled and First Aid cover will be available.**

### START/FINISH

**Also** Explorer OS 297 required for 20 + 40k routes

Free car parking is available at Myrtle Park Primary School on a first come first served basis.

### TIMES

40k - Check in & start from 0800 -0900hrs.

20k - Check in & start from 0930 - 1030hrs

10k - Check in & start from 1100 - 1230hrs

### FINISH

**All routes - not before 1400hrs BUT before 1800hrs**

**If entering the 40k and wanting to eat you must return by 1700hrs**

All entrants must pass through all appropriate checkpoints and obtain a log in. None must be missed and the times stated adhered to. **Runners should thus set off later.**

All bookings for the 40k route must be pre-booked one week in advance with up-to-date contact information. This distance is subject to minimum entry numbers.

The rules and conditions of acceptance contained within are correct at the time of printing and may be subject to alteration by the organisation, should the necessity arise.
