Join Chair of the Friends of Bracken Hall and experienced walk leader, John Dallas, to explore Bradford's countryside, all starting opposite Bracken Hall, Glen Road, Baildon, BD17 5EA.

Please come prepared for the weather! We recommend you bring:

- comfortable waterproof footwear
- suitable clothing to keep you warm and dry
- a supply of water and a snack
- a hot drink if it's chilly
- sun screen and a hat if it's hot

Where a walk is marked with (#), you will require some money for public transport. The nature of the countryside terrain means that most of these walks require a moderate level of fitness and agility and some sections have limited accessibility.

Name:	To and from Bingley St. Ives
Start location:	Opposite Bracken Hall
Leader:	John Dallas
Details:	Through Shipley Glen, passing Crag Hebble Dam, down 'Conker Avenue', Hirst Lock, Hirst Wood and alongside the River Aire to Beck Lane and to St. Ives. We'll be returning through Bingley, over the railway and along the Leeds & Liverpool Canal and River Aire to Trench Meadows and Shipley Glen.

Name:	To Thackley Open Air School
Start location:	Opposite Bracken Hall
Leader:	John Dallas
Details:	From Shipley Glen and along Baildon Bank to Browgate and down footpaths to the valley bottom at the Baildon/Thackley boundary bridge. Up through lower Thackley and into the woods to the site of the former school. We'll return through the woods and along the Leeds and Liverpool Canal, through Shipley, Saltaire and Roberts Park and then up the Shipley Glen Tramway bridleway.

Name:	To Gilstead and the Prince of Wales Park
Start location:	Opposite Bracken Hall
Leader:	John Dallas
Details:	Through Shipley Glen, up and along Sparable Lane, passing and looking into the site of Titus Salts' sons food producing gardens and orchards and along to Gilstead, then Gilstead Moor and across Park Road to the park. We'll return through Gawthorpe, 5-Rise Locks, alongside the Leeds and Liverpool Canal and River Aire and Shipley Glen.
