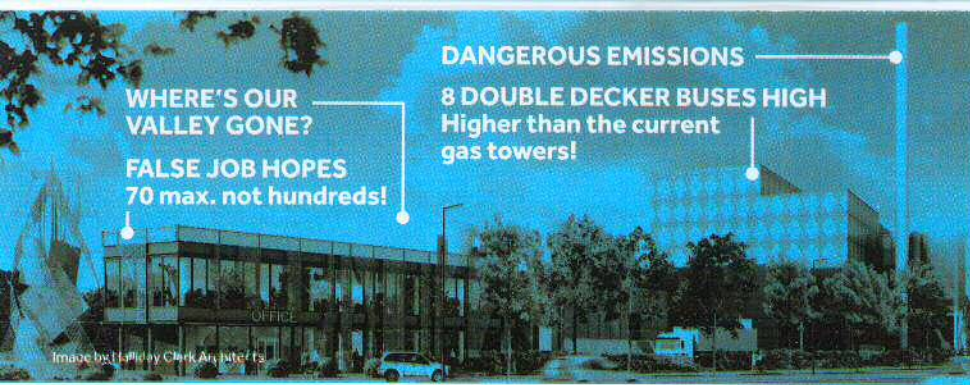

HEARD ABOUT THE PLANNED INCINERATOR?

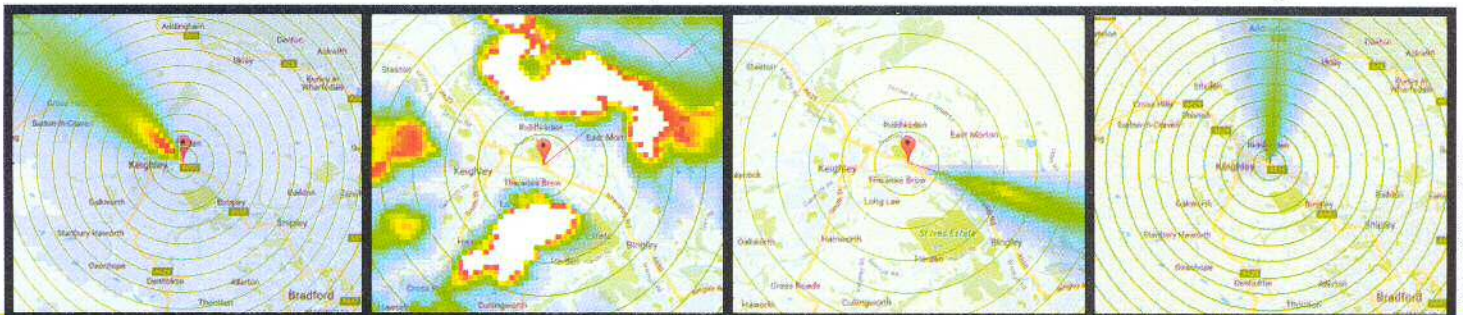
We are Aire Valley Against Incineration and we say **NO** to the 'Waste to Energy' commercial and industrial waste incinerator at Marley (the old gas works site) near Keighley.

- It is called a 'Clean Energy Complex' but it's just another name for an incinerator that will burn all day, every day
- **We are concerned about the health issues** – the ultra fine particles that will be released are linked to breathing difficulties and an increased risk of birth defects. This valley has been known as 'Asthma Valley' for many years. We want to breathe clean air in the Aire Valley!
- **Incinerators are NOT green**; they are the worst method of waste disposal as they discourage recycling and add to greenhouse gases
- **What will it burn?** Commercial and industrial waste, not waste from houses. No-one will tell us where this waste will come from. No-one will tell us what sort of waste it will be. No-one can predict exactly what pollutants it will produce but we can tell from Plume Plotter how far it will spread! www.plumeplotter.com/airevalley – see below

- **HGV traffic will increase**, adding to the already congested roads around Keighley. Up to 70 heavy goods vehicle trips each day, from Monday to Saturday, will bring commercial waste to the incinerator and take toxic ash away
- **The incinerator is going to be built next to green belt in a valley**; the fallout it will produce won't blow away easily and will build up, especially on the valley sides, where there are homes. The heavier particles that are more toxic will be deposited locally, on the land and in the water
- **The incinerator will be huge!** Eight double-decker buses tall with a stack almost 200ft tall for people to see from miles around. It is ugly, out of proportion and out of keeping with the current low rise units and rural approach to Keighley
- **We could witness a downturn in the area's economy.** The Aire Valley and surrounding areas (like Haworth and Ilkley Moor) are popular with both locals and tourists. The National Trust property, East Riddlesden Hall, a popular wedding venue, is less than 500 metres from where the incinerator will be built. Canal boat holidays on the Leeds to Liverpool canal may not be so attractive when the view includes a large incinerator! The effect will be felt as far as Haworth and Saltaire and beyond
- **The developers have made false promises about jobs at the incinerator, raising hopes of employment.** Most jobs will be during the construction phase with specialist staff brought in by the contractor. Afterwards there may be less than 70 people needed, NOT the hundreds promised
- **Homes around an incinerator have become harder to sell** and lost some of their value in other parts of the UK.

MOST LOCAL AREAS WILL BE AFFECTED...

The images below show the (predicted) current state of pollution from the planned incinerator. The red line shows wind direction. Green rings show distance (km). The overlay shows the concentration of oxides of nitrogen at ground level.
